

Altona Complex Neighbourhood Consultative Group Report for April 2015 meeting

City West Water (CWW) has Trade Waste Agreements with three companies in the Altona Complex Neighbourhood Consultative Group (ACNCG): BASF, Dow and Qenos. These agreements provide rights and obligations of the companies to discharge trade waste into CWW's sewerage system.

The following is a summary of the current progress and issues relating to each customer.

BASF

BASF is currently compliant with its Trade Waste Agreement.

DOW

Dow is currently compliant with its new Trade Waste Agreement, which was renewed in December 2014.

QENOS (OLEFINS AND RESINS)

Qenos holds two agreements with CWW, one for the Olefins plant, the other for Resins.

Olefins

The Qenos Olefins Trade Waste Agreement was renewed in April 2015. The site's new Trade Waste Agreement retains the bulk of requirements and obligations that existed within the site's previous Trade Waste Agreement.

Qenos Olefins is currently non-compliant for a number of minor Sulphide breaches which occurred in December 2014 and January 2015. Investigations by Qenos suggest the non-compliances relate to the cleaning frequency of the site's treatment plant. It is expected the issue will be resolved in April.

Resins

Qenos Resins is currently compliant with its Trade Waste Agreement.
