EMT – March and September 2015

- EMT Meeting held in March this year and next meeting scheduled in September.
- March EMT presented at April's ACNCG.
- It was agreed with the EMT members to meet twice a year instead of three for 2015 as they felt more benefit from two meetings rather than three.
- This presentation has captured site events that have occurred since the last EMT and ACNCG.

Site Shut Down (3rd – 8th August 2015)

Planned activities include:

- Vessel cleaning;
- Plant upgrades including installation of double mechanical seals on reactor and cooling vessels;
- Site Training – CPR, Chemical Management and Internal Emergency Response Training; and
- Regulatory Vessel Inspections.



Waste Review

- Audit of all waste streams on site.
- Testing of waste streams to identify areas where waste can be re-classified or recycled rather than being disposed of as prescribed waste.
- Currently finalizing disposal options with Waste Contractors and will report final outcomes in next EMT.



Promotion/Implementation of “My Safe Way” Program

- Safety Leadership initiative through online training program to all site staff;
- Series of Tool Box Talks focusing on prevention of incidents and site/self responsibilities;
- Guest Speaker talking on the importance of thinking before you act.



EPA

- BASF Accredited EPA Licence will be issued in the new EPA format. BASF have provided EPA with latest information for this to be achieved.
- No update or correspondence from the EPA regarding the next stages of the Accredited Licencee Pilot Program.
- Air testing from the Thermal Oxidiser completed in June as per EPA Licence requirements. Waiting on final results.

CWW

- Continued monthly sampling and analysis program with nothing out of spec to report.

WorkSafe

- Nothing to report.
