COMPANY UPDATE

- 1. Dow Chemical became independent from DowDupont on April 1st 2019
 - > This was a planned "spin off" that was announced when Dow and Dupont merged in 2017
 - > There is no change to the Altona operation

- 2. Personal Injury Performance
 - > <u>ZERO</u> recordable injuries since May 2016
- 3. Loss of Containment Performance
 - > <u>ZERO</u> recordable containment loss events since March 2018





REGULATORY COMPLIANCE

• <u>EPA</u>

- > No remedial notices issued since last update
- License compliance assessment completed in December 2018
- WorkSafe
 - > Altona Site completed the Annual Major Hazard Facility Annual Inspection in January
 - ✓ No major findings
 - WorkSafe also conduct quarterly oversight visits
 - > There have been no reportable events

<u>City West Water</u>

> No exceedance of discharge limits since last update





EH&S IMPROVEMENT PLANS 2019

- Implementation of updated Safety Standards across Dow
- Improving sample points
- Reducing process safety risks with implementation of additional control measures





REMEDIATION UPDATES

- 13th Clean Up Plan Progress report delivered to the EPA on 30 April 2019
- Radio Frequency Heating: the system will be powered by 266 ground solar panels
- <u>Shell Recycling Project</u>: Planning Permit application to be lodged with City Council later in May 2019
