DOW ALTONA SITE UPDATE

- 1. Closure of Manufacturing at the P.O.D. plant
 - > Final stages of decommissioning of the manufacturing plant are underway
 - Warehousing and distribution continue at the site with imported Propylene Glycols and Polyols
 - Services modification works to support Dow and tenant operations are in progress
 - Demolition work is planned for late 2020 / early 2021
- 2. Personal Injury Performance
 - Last reportable injury was May 2019
- 3. Loss of Containment Performance
 - ZERO recordable containment loss events



REGULATORY COMPLIANCE

EPA

- ➤ License compliance assessment scheduled for Feb 2020
- > APS and NGERS reporting completed in September 2019

WorkSafe

- > There have been no reportable events
- Major Hazard Facility de-registration submission is being prepared

City West Water

No license or permit breaches



ALTONA REMEDIATION UPDATE

- On 3 February 2020 EPA issued a new draft Clean Up Notice requesting a "total assessment" of the site:
 - > The current CUN will be revoked
 - > A new Clean Up Plan to be developed
 - > The new Clean Up Plan will have to be verified by an EPA-appointed environmental Auditor
- In the interim, all the existing monitoring, assessment and remediation works will continue with modifications as required
