 - Olefins trade waste sulphides being investigated..
 - Olefins high water temp excursion on 22nd Oct under investigation.
 - Recycled water commenced in June 2015
 - >80% Olefins water from recycled water
- Worksafe
 - Annual site verification visits conducted in October.
 - Waiting for formal report
- Energy Safe Victoria (ESV)
 - Waiting for formal approval of Safety Management Plan for our licensed pipelines
 - Submitted renewal application for Electrical Safety Management Scheme
