2018 Qenos Focus Areas



Community engagement across a number of aspects have YTD.

- February joint EMT
- Odour audit scheduled for May 8th
- Consultation
 - Qenos invited by Department of Environment & Energy to host OECD meeting on Environmental regulations on 23rd March to provide input on chemical regulations
- Community notification.
 - Advertisement in Star weekly to inform broader community of April Major Maintenance activities
 - Supported by Qenos and ACNCG website notifications.
- Complaints
 - 1 noise complaint (13/2) confirmed from Charles Road.
 - 6 odour complaints from Charles Road classified as Plausible complex.



Positive engagement with multiple regulators

- EPA
 - Clean Up Plan for PFAS submitted to EPA in March.
 - Expect formal EPA response in 2Q.
 - Accepted EPA invitation to Good Environmental Site Practices workshop 8th March
- CWW
 - Olefins Trade Waste Licence renewed.
- Worksafe
 - 2 March – Technician brushed live equipment. Worksafe and ESV notified
 - 23 March - Furnace Fan tripped causing positive firebox pressure. Caused small fire on silicon sealant. Worksafe Notified
 - 13th April - Ethylene leak .MFB attended event. Worksafe had site follow up Investigation report pending.
 - Worksafe visit to Resins following up from 2017 incident

 - Notification above
